

DAAD. PROJECT «UKRAINE DIGITAL – REMOTE LAB OF URBAN PLANNING» KARLSRUHE INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY AND ODESSA STATE ACADEMY OF CIVIL ENGINEERING AND ARCHITECTURE. GOALS, OBJECTIVES AND PROSPECTS.

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Odessa State Academy of Civil Engineering and Architecture has been cooperating with the Karlsruhe University of Technology since 2016. During this time, we took part in the project «Unloved legacy of a socialist city? » (2016-2019), in the joint program «The Future of Modernist Housing». Teachers, graduate students and students have gained valuable experience working with KIT. The results of these studies are embedded in graduation projects and are used in the development of scientific and methodological materials. Many of them won prizes in international competitions, were highly appreciated at exhibitions and presentations. At present Karlsruhe Institute of Technology and Odessa State Academy of Civil Engineering and Architecture take part in the project of DAAD «Ukraine digital – Remote Lab of Urban Planning».

DAAD (Deutscher Akademischer Austauschdienst) is the largest all-German association on the rights of a public organization to support international academic exchanges. It is engaged in the exchange of scientists and students. The main goals of DAAD are to support the younger generation in Germany and abroad in the fields of science and culture, economics and politics, educate them in a spirit of openness and mutual understanding, as well as increase the internationality and prestige of German universities.

At the working stage of the project «Ukraine digital - Remote Lab of Urban Planning», it is already possible to assess its significance for OSACEA. This is primarily professional knowledge, experience of professional international communication, experience of online learning, as well as high interest and responsibility of students. Sixty masters take part in the project.

Project «Ukraine digital – Remote Lab of Urban Planning» consists of three courses: Seminar ‘Metropol.x_Kyiv’ Lecture ‘Urban Resilience, Urban Design Class.. Topic of courses: Urban Resilience. All classes organized in tandems, so someone from OSACEA and someone from KIT. All classes are included in the schedule of OSACEA. New programs for computer graphics

and remote work in the project will to be used in other disciplines taught in OSACEA. English is working language of the project.

In terms of joint work, participation in the project «Built Heritage. History and Perspectives» is of particular importance for OSACEA, Odessa in Ukraine. The project is in line with the Curricula of the OSACEA Educational Programs. Sixty masters and thirty bachelors will take part in the project.

Project «Built Heritage. History and Perspectives» will also consist of three courses: Seminar. Metropol.x_Built Heritage in Lviv., Lecture. Built Heritage. History and Perspectives, Urban Design class - Renovation of the historic center of Odessa. The project courses are a more detailed study of the modern features of individual OSACEA disciplines. All classes will be organized in tandems, with someone from OSACEA and someone from KIT. The project will support the formation of modern modern methods of vocational training and the improvement of education in our universities using new information and communication tools, preservation of architectural school Odessa, strengthening of international relations in this difficult time for Ukraine. Our future is our graduates who, using their professional knowledge, will restore Ukraine.
